In the present petition, the challenge is to the order dated 23.10.2024 (Annexure P-2), whereby the claim of the petitioner for counting the part time service rendered by her starting from 31.01.1995 to 22.01.2015 towards qualifying service for the grant of pensionary benefits, has been declined by the respondents.

Keeping in view the advance copy given, Mr. Amarpreet Singh Bains, Asstt. Advocate General, Punjab, appears on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents on instructions from Mr. Dheeraj Vashist, Deputy D.E.O., Hoshiarpur, submits that the order dated 23.10.2024 (Annexure P-2) impugned in the present petition be treated as withdrawn with liberty to pass a fresh order in accordance with law by taking into consideration the judgment of the Division Bench of this Court in CWP



No.2371 of 2010 titled as *Harbans Lal Vs. State of Punjab and others*, decided on 31.08.2010, as well as judgment of this Court in CWP No. 10238 of 2017 titled as *Jeewan Lata Vs. State of Punjab and others*, decided on 10.05.2019 so as to grant the benefit of past service rendered by the petitioner before her services were regularized while computing the pensionary benefits admissible to the petitioner and the said order will be passed within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of copy of this order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
