SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J (ORAL)

1. The jurisdiction of this Court under Section 482 Cr.P.C., has been invoked seeking directions to respondents No.1 to 3 not to register any false FIR without conducting a proper investigation.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that a false complaints have been filed by respondents No.5 to 7 against the petitioners in various police stations in Punjab just to harass them and all the complaints are completely baseless and without any truth in it. The petitioners are being harassed by the police authorities in the name of investigations. A reference of such type complaint dated 18.05.2023 (Annexure P-9) has also been made by the petitioners.
3. Though there is no representation submitted to the respondents No. 1 to 4 by the petitioners, however learned counsel prays that the present petition be treated as a representation and petitioners would be satisfied, in case a direction is issued to the authorities to decide the same in a time bound manner.
4. Without going into the merits of the case and the nature of allegations levelled in the present petition, Commissioner of Police, Amritsar is directed to treat

the present petition as a representation and to look into the allegations levelled therein and to decide it by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. Petition stands disposed off in the aforesaid terms.
