The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.51 dated 04.05.2022 registered under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC and Section 13 of the Punjab Travel Professionals (Regulation) Act, 2014 at Police Station Mukerian, District Hoshiarpur.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 21.12.2023, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 21.12.2023 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
