1. Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus directing respondents No. 2 and 3 to release the detenue, who is wife of the petitioner, from the illegal detention of respondents No. 4 to 6.

2. After issuance of notice of motion by this Court vide order dated 18.12.2023, the jurisdictional police officer has produced the detenue before the concerned Jurisdictional Magistrate and her statement under Section 164 of Cr.P.C. was recorded, in which she has clearly stated that she is happily residing with his family. The status report dated 22.01.2024 by way of affidavit of Tarun Saini, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police Ladwa, Kurukshetra has been filed on behalf of official respondents. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. Faced with the aforesaid situation, learned counsel for petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition.
4. In view of the above, the present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.
