1. In the present writ petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that the petitioner is not being granted the benefit of compassionate appointment after the death of her father only on the ground that she is married daughter of the deceased by ignoring the settled principle of law settled by this Court in ***CWP No.2218 of 2017 titled as Amarjit Kaur vs. State of Punjab and another, decided on 17.01.2020 (Annexure P-7).***

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he has already received the copy of the reply through mail wherein, the Committee after examining the claim of the petitioner, has already recommended the grant of compassionate appointment.

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3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the Chief Engineer who has to issue appropriate order appointing the petitioner on compassionate appointment, is not complying with the recommendation of the Committee dated 12.11.2024.

4. Learned State counsel submits that appropriate order keeping in view the recommendation of the Committee dated 12.11.2024, will be passed by the Chief Engineer within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
