The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to deposit the entire compensation along with interest and release the same immediately as determined by Competent Authority, Land Acquisition-cum-District Revenue Officer, Hoshiarpur, vide award no.26 dated 12.04.2023 (Annexure P-5).

Pursuant to previous order dated 06.02.2024 Mr. Arvind Parkash, CALA-cum-DRO-Hoshiarpur is present in the Court. He has submitted that the land of the petitioner was acquired and qua that two separate awards were passed. Therefore, he has brought demand draft bearing No.048803 dated 19.02.2024 for the amount payable to the petitioner on account of both the acquisition as per the awards dated 02.03.2023 and 12.04.2023.

Accordingly, the demand draft along with calculations have been handed over to the counsel for the petitioner for onward encashment in the account of the petitioner.

In view of the above, at this stage, the present petition is rendered infructuous.

Dismissed.

However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, she would be at liberty to approach the Court again with specific grievance.

Personal appearance of aforesaid officer is exempted.
