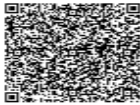

Present petition has been filed under Section 483 read with Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of interim bail to the petitioner in FIR No.7 dated 07.01.2023, under Sections 21(c), 23, 29 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short 'NDPS Act') registered at Police Station Sadar Fazilka for a period of one week to perform the last rites of his father to be held on 04.12.2024.

2. Learned counsel contends that petitioner's father expired on 18.11.2024 and Bhog ceremony is to be held on 04.12.2024 at Village Chak Balochan Wala. Further submits that petitioner being the elder son, has to perform the rituals.

3. Notice of motion.



4. At this stage, Mr. T.P.S. Walia, learned AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent and on instructions, fairly acknowledged the factum of death of petitioner’s father and submits that presence of the petitioner would be necessary to perform the Bhog ceremony.

In view of the fair stand taken by learned State counsel, this Court deems it appropriate to dispose off the present petition with direction that petitioner be taken to perform Bhog ceremony of his father on 04.12.2024 at 10.00 A.M in police custody and he be brought back in the evening on the same day i.e. 04.12.2024 at 5.00 P.M before the Jail authorities.
6. The above observations be not construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case in any manner.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
