1. The petitioner invoking the inherent powers of this Court has filed this petition under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023 being aggrieved by the fact that the absconding accused in FIR No. 114 dated 17.10.2024 under Sections 109, 115(2), 118, 126(2), 361(2), 191(3) and 190 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS), 2023 registered at Police Station City-2, Malerkotla, District Malerkotla are threatening and intimidating the petitioner.
2. The petitioner has filed an application/representation dated 04.11.2024 (Annexure P-2) before the Senior Superintendent of Police (SSP), Malerkotla for seeking appropriate security.

3. The same shall be considered and decided by the SSP, Malerkotla in accordance with law and if the security is due to the petitioner, the same shall be provided or else if no security is due, then a reasoned order shall be passed and communicated to the petitioner accordingly.
