2. It is, inter alia, submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners have been in litigation with private respondents No. 4 to 9, who happen to be their relatives and in order to pressurise the petitioners, private respondents No. 4 to 9 are extending threats to the petitioners and as such feeling apprehension to their life and liberty, the petitioners have approached the official respondents time and again by moving various representations but no action till date has been taken thereon.

3. He further submits that for the purpose of this petition, the petitioners will be satisfied if the directions are issued to the official respondents, particularly to respondent No. 3, i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar-Rural, Amritsar, to consider and dispose of the representation (Annexure P-9) in accordance with the law in an expeditious manner.
4. Notice of motion to the official respondents.
5. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sarabjit Singh Cheema, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of official respondents No. 1 to 3.
6. After hearing the respective submissions; considering the averments made in the petition and without commenting on the merits thereon, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 3-the Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar-Rural, Amritsar, to consider the averments made in the representation (Annexure P-9) and dispose of the same in an expeditious manner under the provisions of the law.
7. Decision so taken be intimated to the petitioners.
