KIRTI SINGH, J.(Oral)

1. The present appeal has been filed against impugned order dated 16.11.2024 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Bhiwani whereby anticipatory bail application of the appellant has been dismissed in case FIR No.279 dated 26.10.2024 registered under Sections 115(2), 3(5), 331(6), 351(2) of BNS, 2023 (Section 3(2)(va) of SC/ST Act, 1989 added later on) at Police Station Siwani, District Bhiwani, Haryana.

2. Learned State counsel on instructions from DSP Jai Bhagwan submits that in compliance of order dated 02.12.2024, the appellant has joined the investigation and are not required for any further investigation.

3. Having considered the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the appeal is allowed. Order dated 02.12.2024 passed by this Court, is hereby made absolute.

4. This order should not be treated as "blanket" order. It will not be read

granting the appellant indefinite protection from arrest. It shall be confined to the



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FIR mentioned *ibid* and will not operate in respect of any other incident that involves commission of an offence.

5. This order does not in any manner limit or restrict the rights or duties of the police or investigating agency to investigate into the charges against the appellant.

6. The accused/appellant shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade them from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer.

7. The accused/appellant shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.

8. The accused/appellant shall join investigation as and when called by the police.

9. It will be open to the police or the investigating agency to move to this Court for a direction under Section 483(3) of BNSS, 2023 to arrest the accused, in the event of violation of any term, such as absconding, non-cooperating during investigation, evasion, intimidation or inducement to witnesses with a view to influence outcome of the investigation or trial.
