1. This is a contempt petition filed under Article 215 of the Constitution of India read with Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 01.09.2023 passed in CWP-19313-2023.

Mr. Pawan Kumar Longia, DAG, Haryana, has accepted notice on behalf of the respondent and produced copy of order dated 28.09.2023, to show that pursuant to the order dated 01.09.2023, the respondent has now decided the legal notice and, therefore, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
