Present writ petition has been filed for directing respondents No.2 to 4 to remove the encroachment and restore the common Drain/Nalla which has been illegally demolished and occupied from the Panchayat street/drainage by respondent No.7 and his family members which has resulted into public nuisance at large due to poor drainage management in the area. Further prayer has been made for directing respondents No.2 and 3 to decide the representation dated 04.12.2023 (Annexure P-3) within a time bound manner.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners has submitted before this Court that for the redressal of grievances of the petitioners, they have already filed their representation dated 04.12.2023 (Annexure P-3) before respondents No.2 and 3 but no decision has been taken on the same till date. She further submits that the petitioners will be

satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.3 i.e. the District Development and Panchayat Officer, Ludhiana to decide the same in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to the official respondents at this stage.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Navneet Singh, Sr. DAG, Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 6.

In view of the above position, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-the District Development and Panchayat Officer, Ludhiana to look into the representation of the petitioners dated 04.12.2023 (Annexure P-3) and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from today.
