This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for disobedience of order dated 18.04.2023 passed in CR-2283-2023.

Learned counsel for the respondents has produced copy of order dated 08.12.2023 and has submitted that the order has been complied with and the amount could not be refunded to the petitioner because of pendency of the matter before the Civil Court.

Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions from Mr. Gurpreet Singh, L.A. Deptt. of Rural Development, Punjab, who is present in the Court, has submitted that in case the petitioner withdraws the suit filed before the trial Court relating to the auction in question, then even the security amount will be refunded to him within a period of one week from the date of submission of copy of order of withdrawal of the suit.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.

However, the petitioner would be at liberty to file fresh petition, in case the needful is not done.
