1. Instant petition has been filed by the petitioner against his transfer order dated 29.08.2024 (Annexure P-4) whereby he has been transferred from Jalandhar to Hoshiarpur.

2. It has been stated that the petitioner is having 62% physical disability (visually impaired) and mother of the petitioner is also suffering from cancer. He is facing extreme difficulties and the transfer is against the policy dated 20.09.2021 (Annexure P-3). Therefore, he has submitted a representation dated 03.10.2024 (Annexure P-5), which is still pending consideration with the department.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage, petitioner would be satisfied, if the said representation is considered and decided by passing a speaking order in a time-bound
