1. Present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for quashing the order dated 06.11.2023 (Annexure P-12) vide which petitioner has been awarded the punishment of removal from service under Rule 5 of the Punjab Civil Services (Punishment and Appeal) Rules, 1970 and for directing the respondents to reinstate the petitioner back in service w.e.f. 06.11.2023 along with all consequential benefits including pay and allowances for the intervening period.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that against the order dated 06.11.2023, petitioner has submitted representation dated 02.01.2024 (Annexure P-13), however, no action has been taken by the respondents on the same. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage, petitioner would be satisfied, if the said representation

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the present petition, respondent No.1 is directed to consider and decide the claim made by the petitioner in representation dated 02.01.2024 (Annexure P-13) in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
