Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the claim which has been raised in the present petition has already been allowed in favour of the Senior Patwaris' by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide **CWP No. 5382 of 2003 titled as "Baljinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others" decided on 04.08.2023** hence, the petitioner be also granted the benefit of the said judgment.
2. Notice of motion.
3. On the asking of the Court, Mr. T.P.S. Chawla, Sr. DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, any representation is received at the hand of the petitioner raising the claim by placing reliance upon the judgment in **Baljinder Singh (supra)** so as to claim the similar benefit, appropriate decision on the said representation will be passed within a period of eight



weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioner in the speaking order to be passed and the said order will be duly conveyed to the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to file appropriate representation.
