1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 21.09.2017 passed by this Court in CWP-13820-2015.
2. Learned counsel for the respondent has submitted that the order dated 21.09.2017 passed in CWP-13820-2015 has been complied with and fresh order dated 04.04.2018 has been passed and copy of the same is taken on record.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has not disputed the aforesaid fact.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unaddressed, she would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
