Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that without giving any finding in the impugned order that the son of the petitioner was having his own income or was being supported by his wife in any manner, again the claim of medical reimbursement has been declined despite the fact that as per Annexure P-2, a certificate has already been given by the Block Primary Education Officer, Hoshiarpur that the son of the petitioner was dependent upon him so as to claim reimbursement.
