This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for disobeying the order dated 22.05.2023 passed in CWP-11216-2023.

Compliance report on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 has been filed today in the Court. The same is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan the same and place it at appropriate place.

Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that the order dated 22.05.2023 passed in CWP-11216-2023 has been complied with and the petitioner has been put on job and is drawing his salary regularly. Even the amounts have been paid to the petitioner through cheques. Necessary payment details and copies of cheques have also been annexed with the aforesaid compliance report.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.

However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-redressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
