The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus seeking direction to respondents No.2 to 5 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioner and his family members at the hands of respondents No.6 to 11.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will be satisfied in case a direction be issued to respondent No.3 to look into the complaint dated 07.12.2023 (Annexure P-4), within a time bound manner.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Anmol Singh Sandhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

However, without advertng to the merits of the case as has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner as well, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur, Punjab, to look into the complaint dated 07.12.2023 (Annexure P-4) and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
