1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.984 dated 27.10.2023 under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat.

2. On 16.01.2024, learned counsel for the petitioner had made the following submissions:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that petitioner was closely related to the complainant and was being treated as their son ever since he was an infant; the property in question had been transferred voluntarily by the complainant in his name and the allegations levelled in the FIR in question were patently false and fabricated as some other close relatives had been eyeing the said property.”

3. Thereafter, vide order dated 22.02.2024, the petitioner had been granted the concession of interim bail and was asked to join

investigation.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 22.02.2024, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

5. Learned State counsel, on instructions, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. She, on further instructions, submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less for his custodial interrogation.

6. In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 22.02.2024, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
