NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. Instant petition has been filed by the petitioner for directing the respondent-authorities to count his past service w.e.f. 23.07.1992 till 25.06.2012 as regular service for the purpose of increment and pensionary benefit.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the purpose of aforesaid relief, petitioner filed representation dated 15.09.2023 (Annexure P-10). However, neither the relief has been granted nor the said representation has been decided by the respondents. He submits that at this stage, petitioner would be satisfied, if the said representation is considered and decided by passing a speaking order in a time-bound frame.

3. Notice of motion.

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4. Mr. Rajesh Sehgal, Addl. A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and has no objection to the innocuous prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record of the case.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the present petition, respondent No.4 is directed to consider and decide the claim made by the petitioner in representation dated 15.09.2023 (Annexurs P-10) in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

7. The petition stands disposed of.
