1. Instant writ petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India directing the respondent-Corporation not to effect recovery from the petitioner pending the decision of the application for stay made in the appeal dated 25.11.2024 (Annexure P-2) filed by the petitioners against orders dated 08.10.2024/09.10.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by respondent No.2 whereby recovery has been imposed upon the petitioners and ordered to be recovered from their salary in the ratio of 60:40.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied if time-bound directions are issued to the respondent-Corporation to consider and decide the said appeal and till



decision of the said appeal, no recovery may be effected from the petitioners.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. T.S. Sidhu, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that the appeal filed by the petitioners shall be decided expeditiously.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the case file.

6. Respondent No.1-Appellate Authority is directed to decide the appeal dated 25.11.2024 (Annexure P-2) along with application for stay filed by the petitioners, in accordance with law by passing a speaking order as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Further recovery from the petitioners shall remain stayed and would be subject to the final order that may be passed by the Appellate Authority.

7. Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
