By way of present petition filed under Section 528 of BNSS for directing the respondent No.1 to 3 that they shall take necessary steps and to take appropriate legal action against respondent No.4 to 5 who are trying and making an attempt to forcibly take away the vehicle of the petitioner bearing registration No. PB03-AT-9647.

2. It is, *inter alia*, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is the owner of the truck bearing registration No.PB03-AT-9647 which he got financed from respondent No.4 and 5 as is evident from Annexure P-1. He further contends that respondent No.4 and 5 with the help of their henchmen are threatening to take forcible possession of the vehicle and as such the petitioner apprehends danger to his life and liberty, he had moved representation dated 10.10.2024 (Annexure P-2) to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, District Ferozepur, but till date no action thereon has been taken to redress the grievance of the petitioner. He submits that for the purpose of the petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.2- Senior



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Superintendent of Police, District Ferozepur, to consider and dispose of the representation dated 10.10.2024 (Annexure P-2) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner by giving opportunity of being heard to the petitioner as well.

3. Notice of motion to official respondents No.1 to 3.
4. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Seena Sandhu, Addl. A.G. Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, District Ferozepur, will consider and dispose of the representation in accordance with law.
5. After hearing the respective submissions and perusing the record, without commenting on the merits of the case and considering the limited request made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, District Ferozepur, to consider and dispose of the representation dated 10.10.2024 (Annexure P-2) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner after giving opportunity of being heard to the petitioner.
6. The decision so taken be also intimated to the petitioner as well.
