The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *certiorari* quashing the result of Subject Knowledge Test, dated 28.10.2024, Annexure P-11, held on 06.10.2024 for the posts of Assistant Director (Technical)-Principal and Vice Principal, on account of the question paper being out of syllabus. Further, a direction has been sought to re-conduct the said examination.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before respondent no.3. At this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent no.3 is directed to decide his pending representation, dated 24.10.2024, Annexure P-10, in a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Tanushree Gupta, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents no.1 and 2. Mr. Balwinder Sangwan, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondent no.3/HPSC, and submits that the pending representation, dated 24.10.2024, will be decided by



respondent no.3/Secretary, Haryana Public Service Commission, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within six weeks.

- 5. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.
- 6. Ordered accordingly.
- 7. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioner.
