The petition has been filed seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to release the benefit of two annual increments as also the salary for suspension period of eleven months and fifteen days, with effect from 25.07.2019 to 10.07.2020. Further, a direction has been sought to release the benefit of ACP with effect from April 2022, along with interest at the rate of eighteen per cent per annum.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before the respondents. At this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent no.3 is directed to decide his pending legal notice, dated 30.08.2024, Annexure P-4, in a specified period.
3. Notice of motion.
4. Ms. Tanushree Gupta, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents, and submits that the pending legal notice, dated 30.08.2024, will be decided by respondent no.3/Director General, Skill Development and Industrial Training, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within three months.



5. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.
6. Ordered accordingly.
7. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioner.
