The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Section 482 Cr.P.C., for issuance of a direction to respondent No.2 to conduct fair and impartial investigation in FIR No.266 dated 19.09.2023, under Section 365 of IPC, 1860 and Section 6 of Prevention of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 added later on, registered at Police Station Hassanpur, District Palwal (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since the registration of the FIR against Mujahid s/o Ruddar, resident of Village Nangla Kanpur, Tehsil Hodal, District Palwal, there is no headway in the investigation.

Looking at the seriousness of the offences, wherein specific allegations are coming forth especially with regard to the abduction of a minor boy aged 16 years.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Baljinder Singh Virk, Sr. DAG Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State, who on instructions from HC Arif

submits that the permission to conduct Polygraph Test of accused Mujahid has already been obtained and, therefore, this Court does not find any reason to interfere at this stage with the Investigating Agency, since it is not even the scope of judicial review to exercise jurisdiction under Section 482 Cr.P.C., to direct the Investigating Agency to conduct the same in a particular manner and time-frame whatsoever.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the instant petition at this stage.

Prayer is accepted.

Dismissed as withdrawn at this stage.
