1. The petitioner is seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.3 to 5 to conduct fair and impartial investigation in FIR No.45 dated 08.10.2024 under Sections 13(1) read with Section 13(2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 as amended by Prevention of Corruption (Amendment) Act, 2018 and Sections 409, 465, 466, 467, 468, 471 of the IPC registered at Police Station Vigilance Bureau Range Amritsar, District Amritsar by considering representation dated 21.11.2024 (Annexure P-2).

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to the official respondents to look into her representation dated 21.11.2024 (Annexure P-2) and take appropriate steps at the earliest.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Navdeep Singh, DAG, Punjab,

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accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

5. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar, District Amritsar (Rural), to look into the representation dated 21.11.2024 (Annexure P-2) and decide the same at the earliest, and take appropriate steps, if any required, in accordance with law.
