1. By way of present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., a prayer has been made for the issuance of direction to official respondents to register FIR against respondents 4 and 5 for house trespass, theft, mischief and manufacturing and forging document.
2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case direction is issued to the official respondents to decide the representation dated 26.09.2023 (Annexure P-9) moved at the instance of petitioner by passing a speaking order expeditiously.
3. Prayer seems to be justified.
4. Upon advance notice, Mr. Shubham Kaushik, AAG, Punjab appears on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and raises no objection to the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.

5. In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Rup Nagar, District Rupnagar to look into the representation dated 26.09.2023 (Annexure P-9) and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of 08 (eight) weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
