1. Instant writ petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for directing respondent No.2-Appellate Authority to decide the statutory appeals dated 12.11.2024 (Annexures P-4, P-5 and P-6) filed by the petitioner against the punishment orders dated 08.10.2024 (Annexures P-1, P-2 and P-3), respectively in a time bound manner. Further prayer has been made to direct respondent No.1 not to effect recovery from the salary of the petitioner pursuant to orders dated 08.10.2024 (Annexures P-1 to P-3), till the decision of the statutory appeals.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for deciding the appeals filed by the petitioner dated 12.11.2024 (Annexures P-4 to P-6) expeditiously by passing a speaking order in a time bound manner.

- 4. Ms. Sunint Kaur, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that the appeals filed by the petitioner shall be decided expeditiously.
- 5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the case file.
- 6. Respondent No.2-Appellate Authority is directed to decide the appeals dated 12.11.2024 (Annexures P-4 to P-6) filed by the petitioner, in accordance with law by passing a speaking order as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Further recovery from the petitioner shall remain stayed and would be subject to the final order that may be passed by the Appellate Authority.
- 7. Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
