1. Through the instant petition preferred under Section 528 of the BNSS, 2023, the petitioner seeks quashing of case FIR no.RC2202022E0013, dated 01.11.2022, registered under Section 13(2) read with Section 13(1)(d) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, and under Section 120-B, 420, 467, 468, 471 of the IPC, at Police Station EO-II, Delhi, District Delhi (Annexure P-2), and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

2. Mr. Deepak Sabherwal, learned Special Public Prosecutor for the respondent-CBI, who is on an advance notice, at the very outset, submits that the CBI has now filed a closure report which has been duly accepted by the learned trial court concerned, while drawing an order

dated 21.08.2023. A liberty has also been extended to the complainant to avail an appropriate remedy before the competent law enforcing agency to further initiate legal action against the guilty persons. A photocopy of the order dated 21.08.2023, is ordered to be taken on record as Mark 'A'.

3. In view of the above submissions, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not want press the instant petition.
