1. The present appellant is aggrieved by the order of the Learned Single Judge whereby the writ petition had been allowed and the respondent-Corporation was asked to pass a fresh order after granting opportunity of hearing to the writ petitioner whose dealership agreement of Gas Agency had been terminated on 17.07.2017. The needful was to be done within a period of 3 months.

2. We are informed by counsel for the respondent-Corporation that the dealership has been restored vide order dated 02.12.2023. The present appeal is also barred by limitation by 124 days having been filed on 20.12.2023, after the order had been passed and necessary application has been filed.

3. In such circumstances, counsel for the appellant does not press the present appeal and prays for liberty to challenge the said order in accordance with law, if permissible.
4. Resultantly, the present appeal is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, with the aforesaid liberty. All pending application(s) also stand disposed of.
