This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for disobedience of the order dated 01.08.2023 passed in CWP-16450-2023.

Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that the order dated 01.08.2023 passed in CWP-16450-2023 has been complied with and necessary registration certificate as registered Pharmacist have also been issued to the petitioners.
