This petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus for directing the official respondents No. 1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of respondents No. 5 to 8.

2. Status report by way of an affidavit dated 08.12.2024 of Sh. Tushar Gupta, IPC, Senior Superintendent of Police, District Sri Muktsar Sahib has been filed in the Court today. The same is taken on record. In the status report, the following has been stated :-

“m) Thus, it was found that the Petitioner Sunder Singh had the apprehension that his wife will be nominated in the FIR, thus, he is leveling false allegations in the representation, during the inquiry all the allegations were found to be false.



Applicant/Petitioner could not produce any witness or evidence in regard to the allegations. Thus, it was recommended that the representation be consigned to record room.

5. That the abovesaid inquiry report of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub- Division Giddarbaha was approved by the deponent on 22/11/2024 and the same was consigned to record room in accordance with law, as no truth was found in the allegations leveled by the petitioner in the representation No. 1665-PC 4/24 dated 23.10.2024 (Annexure P-2 attached with the main petition).”

3. In view of the above, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of accordingly.
