Application for impleading Gurjeet Shaheed and Gurjeet Kaur as necessary/proper parties in the present case and for placing on record amended memo of parties.

Mr. Joginder Pal Ratra, Sr. DAG., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

In view of the fair stand taken by learned State counsel and for the reasons mentioned in the application, same is allowed as prayed for subject to all just exceptions.

Main case

Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of mandamus directing the respondents to protect the life and liberty

of the petitioner along with his family members and not to harass them.

2. Learned State counsel, on instructions from the police official present, has apprised the Court that despite three notices issued to the petitioner, he has not turned up.
3. Faced with the above situation, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that present petition be disposed off as not pressed with liberty to the petitioner to pursue his grievance before the officer concerned.
