Prayer in the present petition is for restraining the respondents from cancelling the registration certificate of the petitioners on the ground of acquiring 10+2 from respondent No.7 without any notice and not to implicate them in false cases.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners contends that the petitioners possessed the qualification of 10+2 from the Board of Higher Secondary Education, Delhi and that the said Board is a National Level Board of Education in India for public and private schools, controlled and managed by the U.P. Education Act, 1921. The certificates issued by the Board of Higher Secondary Education are recognized by the Punjab State Board of Technical Education and Industrial Training as per the letter bearing memo No.PSB/DA/Equiv./2186 dated 03.11.2010 but the petitioners are being harassed by the respondents at this juncture.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners further contends that he would be satisfied at this juncture in case respondent No.6- Punjab State Pharmacy Council is directed to look into the representation submitted by the petitioners on 09.12.2023 (Annexure P-6) before taking any action against them.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Saurav Verma, Addl. A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and Mr. R.S.Kalra, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.6.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.6 contends that respondent No.6 is not contemplating any action against the petitioners as on date and that he would have no objection in the event the present petition is disposed of to take a decision on the representation submitted by the petitioners on 09.12.2023 (Annexure P-6) before any action is proposed to be taken against the petitioners.

The present petition is accordingly **disposed of** without commenting upon the merits and with the consent of the parites that in the event of respondent No.6 proposing to take any action against the petitioners, they shall first take the decision on the representation dated 09.12.2023 (Annexure P-6) submitted by the petitioners after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioners.
