JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to constitute a Committee to re-measure height of the petitioner.
2. The petitioner pursuant to an advertisement applied for the post of Sub Inspector. The petitioner cleared written test and he was subjected to physical and medical examination. During the course of physical examination, his height was measured which was found less than 5’7’ i.e. minimum required height. The candidature of the petitioner was rejected on this sole ground.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondent has wrongly measured height of the petitioner. His actual height is more than 5’7’ whereas it has been wrongly recorded as 5’6.61’. The respondent in respect of another advertisement has constituted a Committee to redress similar grievances. The respondent should

constitute Committee for the redressal of his grievances.

4. Per contra, learned State counsel submits that as per advertisement, the petitioner has remedy of appeal with respect to physical measurement test and physical screening test. The petitioner instead of availing remedy of appeal has approached this Court. If the petitioner prefers an appeal before the Competent Authority, it would be adjudicated within 4 weeks.

5. From the perusal of record, it comes out that petitioner has filed representation dated 04.11.2023 with DGP as well as Chairman Recruitment Board.

6. On being confronted with aforesaid representation, learned State counsel concedes that aforesaid representation would be considered as appeal and an appropriate order would be passed by Chairman, Recruitment Board within 4 weeks from today.

7. Learned counsel for the petitioner agrees with aforesaid arrangement.

8. In the wake of statements of both sides, the present petition stands disposed of.
