Grievance of the petitioner is that FIR No.325 dated 21.12.2020 was registered at Police Station Shahkot under Sections 489, 379, 201, 34 of the IPC against him and others. Petitioner was not challaned though other accused was challaned in that case. Later on, petitioner was summoned vide order dated 12.09.2022 as an additional accused on application under Section 319 Cr.P.C. by the Trial Court concerned. The revision filed by the petitioner was dismissed on 17.07.2023. Petitioner has already challenged those orders by filing a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. before this Court which is pending for 07.02.2024.

Learned counsel has also placed on record copy of an order dated 16.11.2022 passed by Additional Sessions Judge, Jalandhar so as to contend that petitioner has already been allowed the anticipatory bail after being summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C. Learned counsel contends that despite the fact that petitioner has already been allowed bail, the police is harassing him time and again. Petitioner has now approached this Court seeking protection. He also made representation dated 30.11.2023 (Annexure P-7) to Director General of Police, Punjab but not action has been taken.

The present petition is hereby disposed of with the direction to
respondent No.2- Director General of Police, Punjab to look into the
representation (Annexure P-7) and provide protection, if required to the
petitioner, after assessing the threat perception.
