1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to extend him benefit of disability/handicapped allowance.

2. The petitioner claims that he is working with Punjab Police and is suffering from 55% locomotor disability. He had suffered with said disability during service and still he is in service. He has made multiple representations to respondents to grant him disability allowance but to no avail.
