1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 11.09.2023 passed in CWP-7286-2015.
2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the order dated 11.09.2023 passed in CWP-7286-2015 has since been complied with and speaking order has been passed by the competent authority.
3. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
4. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law, if he feels aggrieved of the order passed by the respondent/concerned authority.
