1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 21.11.2022 passed in CWP-26660-2022.
2. Notice of motion.
3. Mr. Pawan Kumar Longia, DAG, Haryana, has accepted notice on behalf of the respondent and has produced copy of the order dated 27.02.2023 to show that pursuant to the order dated 21.11.2022, the respondent has now decided the legal notice. Copy of the order dated 27.02.2023 is taken on record.
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
