This Civil Writ Petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been moved for issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondent authorities to release the pending dues of GPF amounting to ₹1,50,405/- along with interest @ 18% per annum from the due date till its actual realization, to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner while restricting the claim of petitioner submits that the purpose would be served in case respondents are directed to dispose of the representation dated 01.04.2022 (Annexure P/11) in a time bound manner.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Charanpreet Singh, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of the aforesaid limited prayer of petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondents to look into and decide representation dated 01.04.2022 (Annexure P/11) in accordance with law by passing a speaking order and that too within three months positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
