The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of direction to the official respondents to conduct free, fair and impartial inquiry and take appropriate action on the representation dated 25.07.2023 (Annexure P-4) given by the petitioner and to ensure that the petitioner and her family members are not unnecessarily harassed at the hands of the private respondents

2. Notice of motion

3. On the asking of the Court, Mr.V.D. Anand, APP, UT, Chandigarh, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has moved a representation dated 25.07.2023 (Annexure P-4) before respondent No.2 and no action thereupon has been taken till date. He further contends that he would be satisfied at this stage, in case appropriate direction

be issued to respondent No.2, to decide representation dated 25.07.2023 (Annexure P-4) moved by the petitioner within time bound manner.

5. Without going into the merits of the case and calling for any reply, this Court deem it appropriate to issue direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, U.T. Chandigarh, to look into the representation dated 25.07.2023 (Annexure P-4) filed by the petitioner and shall pass a speaking order in accordance with law, within four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

6. In view of the aforesaid direction, the present petition is disposed of.

7. All pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
