1. Instant petition has been filed for quashing advertisement bearing No.CRA 310/24 dated 21.08.2024 (Annexure P-9); for quashing resolution dated 25.11.2023 (Annexure P-2); for directing the respondents to consider the petitioner as eligible for the post of Assistant Engineer/OT (Electrical) as the Gate-2022 is valid upto 31.05.2025.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for seeking the aforesaid relief, petitioner had moved representation dated 29.09.2024 (Annexure P-12). However, no action has been taken thereon till date. He submits that at this stage, petitioner would be satisfied, if the said representation is considered and decided by passing a speaking order in a time-bound frame.

3. Notice of motion.

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4. Mr. Kunal Garg, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and has no objection to the innocuous prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record of the case.

6. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the present petition, respondent No.1 is directed to consider and decide the claim made by the petitioner in representation dated 29.09.2024 (Annexure P-12) in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

7. The petition stands disposed of.
