1. In the present petition, the challenge is to the order dated 11.12.2023 (Annexure P-14) by which, the petitioner has been placed under suspension with immediate effect without assigning any reason and without affording any opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was suspended without there being any decision given to hold a disciplinary proceedings hence, the order of suspension is bad.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from Mr. Ranveer Singh Sodhi, Deputy Director, Mr. Amit Kumar Aggarwal, IAS, Commissioner and Secretary, Development and Panchayat Department, Haryana, submits that the petitioner was suspended so as to initiate disciplinary proceedings and as of now, even the charge sheet has already been served.

4. Learned State counsel further submits that the Department does not intend to implement the order of suspension hence, the present petition may kindly be disposed of as rendered infructuous and liberty be given to the Department to hold the disciplinary proceedings in accordance with law.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as the order of suspension is not being implemented any further, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
