1. In the present writ petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that though the petitioner has been selected for the post of Conductor but the appointment is not being made only on the ground that there is a criminal proceeding pending against the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the grievance which has been raised in the present writ petition, has already been raised by the petitioner in the representation dated 25.10.2023, a copy of which has been appended with this petition as Annexure P-8 and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondent-State to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

4. Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case representation dated 25.10.2023 (Annexure P-8) is received from the petitioner and is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, appropriate order on the same will be passed by the respondents within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
