The prayer in the present petition under Section 483 read with Section 528 of the BNSS is for the grant of interim bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0007 dated 15.02.2019 under Sections 201, 302/34 IPC (Sections 202, 212, 216, 120-B IPC added later on) registered at Police Station GRP Jind, District Jind (As per FIR District GRP Ambala Cantt.) on account of marriage of his younger brother, namely, Vikas on 04.12.2024.

Looking at the facts and circumstances of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to grant interim bail to the petitioner. However, in view of the fact that the younger brother of the petitioner is to get married on 04.12.2024, the Jail Superintendent concerned is directed to send the

petitioner/Ankit in custody to the place including the Venue where the

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marriage ceremony is to take place between 8.00 a.m. to 8.00 p.m. for three days i.e. w.e.f. 04.12.2024 to 06.12.2024. The expenses incurred for the aforesaid purpose shall be borne by the petitioner.

The present petition stands disposed of.
