1. Instant petition has been filed for quashing the action of the respondents vide which the petitioner has not been granted the benefits of 2nd ACP despite being fully eligible under the Assured Career Progression Rules, 2016 dated 28.10.2016 (Annexure P-2). Further prayer has been made for directing the respondents to grant the benefit of 2nd ACP to the petitioner along with all consequential benefits in view of Rules of 2016.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that seeking the benefit of 2nd ACP, petitioner has submitted representation dated 17.07.2024 (Annexure P-6), however, no action has been taken thereon by the respondents till date. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage, petitioner would be satisfied, if the said representation is considered and decided by passing a speaking order in a time-bound frame.

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3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Saurabh Mohunta, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and has no objection to the innocuous prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.
5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record of the case.
6. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the present petition, respondent No.2 is directed to consider and decide the claim made by the petitioner in representation dated 17.07.2024 (Annexure P-6) in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
7. The petition stands disposed of.
