1. This is a contempt petition filed under Article 215 of the Constitution of India read with Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 25.08.2023 passed in CWP-18722-2023.
2. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 25.08.2023 passed in CWP-18722-2023 has been complied with and representation of the petitioner has been decided by passing the speaking order dated 15.02.2024 (Annexure R-2/T).
3. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
4. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, she would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
