- [1] The petitioner is seeking regular bail by way of petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.17 dated 09.02.2020 under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B IPC and Section 13 of Punjab Travel Professional (Regulations) Act, 2014, registered at Police Station Khamanon, District Fatehgarh Sahib, Punjab.
- [2] Status report has not been filed by the respondent-State, despite giving opportunity. However, custody certificate dated 29.01.2024 has been filed in Court today. The same is taken on record.
- [3] Learned State Counsel contends that the matter has already been compromised between the parties vide Annexure P-4, dated 19.12.2023.
- [4] Learned counsel for respondent No.2-complainant is present in Court, concedes the factum of compromise.
- [5] Petitioner is in custody since 04.12.2023.
- [6] Having regard to the above facts and circumstances, particularly

anything further on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
